The robot dog purchased by the former board of Canberra's Brindabella Christian College is now for sale.

The Boston Dynamic 'Agile Mobile Robot' called Spot was purchased in April last year in the United States, by the now-defunct entity that controlled the troubled private school.

Administrators say buying the dog and training to use it cost about \$337,000 — excluding travel.

Their report said the robot was "not a core operational requirement and had no clear link to the college's curriculum or educational outcomes".

Expressions of interest to purchase the robot dog remain open, with the sales process expected to take several months.
